NYC Information

Registration

NYC Registration will be in the Duke Energy Center East Concourse. All participants, visitors, and adults must register to enter competition rooms and participate in activities. Those in grades 1-12 must register for NYC and pay the conference fee. Those ages 3-5, who are attending pre-school worship must register and pay the conference fee. Adults must register for the National and pay a \$10.00 fee to attend any NYC competition or event of any kind. Your name badge must be worn at all times.

NYC Office

The NYC Office is located in the Duke Energy Center Coat Room Level 2.

Reach That Guy

Numerous service projects have been arranged to provide you with the opportunity to help others in need. If you plan to participate in the *Reach That Guy* service project program, please attend one of the orientation meetings (Sunday - 4:00 PM or Monday - 8:00 AM). During the orientation you will be instructed regarding proper attire, departure locations, etc. Please make sure you sign up before all spots are filled. You may do so at the NYC Booth/*Reach That Guy* table located in the DEC Level 2 East Lobby.

Conference Curfew

The city of Cincinnati has a curfew of 11:00 PM for persons under the age of 16. The National Youth Conference has established an 11:30 PM curfew for its participants. Students should not be without an adult sponsor or parent after this time. Hotel and convention center personnel have been informed of this curfew and will assist conference staff in enforcing it.

Truth & Peace

Eighty-seven Free Will Baptist high school students are working this week to make our conference the best it can be. They are designated by a Truth & Peace ribbon on their name tags. Each student has assigned duties they are expected to uphold and are an authorized extension of the conference staff. Should you need assistance or information, please feel free to seek their help. For more information about how you can participate in this program, please come by the NYC office for information.

Conduct - Dress Code

Every aspect of the National Youth Conference, including the competitive activities, seeks to achieve a level of professionalism and excellence that is consistent with our goal of developing Christian leadership and service. For this reason we strive to maintain a high standard of conduct, appearance, and Christian testimony. This event is the highest level of activity for Free Will Baptist students in the nation. All participating students and adults are expected to display the utmost respect for and strict adherence to the following standards:

A. Code of Conduct

The conduct of participants is expected to meet the standard for believers in 1 Timothy 4:12, "be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity." Patience, kindness, and good sportsmanship is the exemplary rule to follow at all times for all participants, sponsors, parents, and visitors. Insubordination or disruptive behavior by any participant, sponsor, parent, or visitor toward any judge(s) or conference official(s) will not be tolerated. Behavior which does not exemplify a Christian will be grounds for disqualification from competition and/or expulsion from the conference.

B. Competition Dress Code

While we do not equate a particular style of dress with holiness, and we do not make judgments of character based on outward appearance, we do recognize the impact that appearance has on behavior, testimony, and influence. The Word of God provides principles to guide us.

Dress and appearance should be modest and promote purity (1 Timothy 2:9-10; 2 Timothy 2:22)

Dress and appearance should not reflect conformity with unholy fashions and patterns of the world (Romans 12:1-2).

Dress and appearance should complement masculinity in men and femininity in women (Genesis 1:27; Deuteronomy 22:5)

Dress and appearance should be appropriate to the occasion, avoid offense, and demonstrate a respect for excellence (1 Corinthians 10:23; 1 Timothy 4:12; Philippians 1:9-10). Dress and appearance should avoid identification with cultural groups that reject Christian teaching (2 Corinthians 6:14-17).

It is understood that Christians may interpret these principles by varying degrees. Our intent is not to define the only standard of Christian dress and appearance, but to uphold a standard that is consistent with the high expectations of performance, conduct, and professionalism that is appropriate for an event of this significance. Specific applications drawn from the principles above include the following policies:

*All clothing should fit properly: no tight pants on men or boys; pants should be worn at the natural waist line and with a belt (no underwear exposed or shirt tails hanging out); no tight dresses, skirts, blouses, or sweaters on ladies or girls.

*Boys and men are to wear a shirt, tie, and slacks (coats are optional). Tank tops and T-shirts are unacceptable.

*Girls and ladies are to wear dresses that shall extend to the knee or longer. Dresses must not be low cut or revealing in style or material. Tops should not expose the waist or midriff. Slacks or pantsuits are unacceptable.

*Semi-formal or formal attire is in order for banquets. Modesty is still to be maintained. Backless dresses and plunging necklines should not be worn.

*Boys and men shall groom their hair so as to follow natural hairline without covering the ears or extending to the eyes or collar.

*Facial piercings, body art, unnatural-colored hair should not be displayed.

Costumes are permitted in specific drama categories. Some flexibility is permitted in the dress code to enable the presentation of a particular character. Use discretion to insure that modesty is maintained. Be creative without compromising this principle. Costumes that do not meet regular Dress Code guidelines may be worn only for competition and reasonable time before and after the event. Costumes are not an excuse to ignore the dress code. Judges will evaluate the appropriateness of costumes and may award points based on how well a costume fits the character and to the degree that a particular costume is required to portray the character.

C. Activity Dress Code

Participants in certain National Youth Conference sponsored off-site and/or physical activities may find it more modest to wear attire other than that stated above. Male participants may wear jeans and T-shirts (provided they do not contain secular slogans). Female participants may wear loose-fitting T-shirts (provided they do not contain secular slogans) and loose-fitting knee-length attire, or loose-fitting slacks. Tops should not expose the waist or midriff. Clothing should not be tattered, ripped, cut, torn, or tied in a revealing manner. During the times when participants are not attending worship services, competition, or NYC-sponsored activities, we request that participants refrain from wearing shorts.

Bible Competition is divided into five different programs:

- 1) Bible Memorization -- Grades 1 through 12
- 2) Bible Sword Drill -- Grades 4, 5, 6
- 3) Bible Millionaire -- Grades 4, 5, 6
- 3) Bible Tic-Tac-Toe -- Grades 7, 8, 9
- 4) Bible Bowl -- Grades 10, 11, 12
- 5) TruthQuest -- Grades 7 through 12

The purpose of competitive activities is to involve young people in a variety of learning experiences that will help build Bible knowledge and train them in individual expression.

The Music and Arts Festival is another way of allowing our youth to discover and develop their talents. In this area of competition there are nine categories in which to compete:
